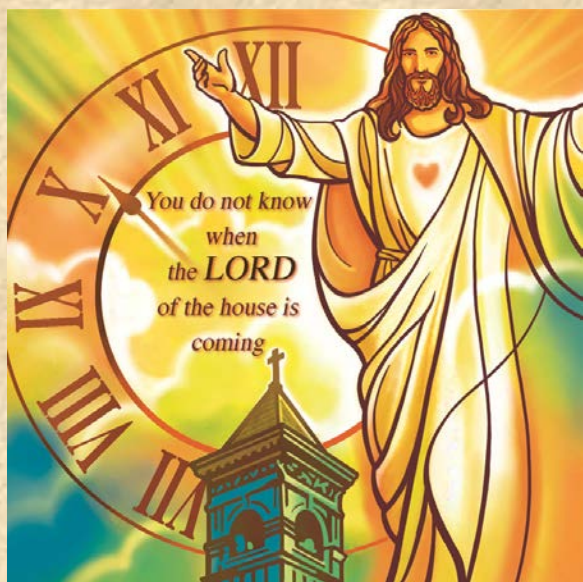

December 3, 2017— First Sunday of Advent Watch Out!

In Advent, we celebrate our hope that the Lord might come more fully into our lives. The first reading from Isaiah voices the hope of sinners for a redeemer. Unlike Isaiah, we know that God has come to bring us back, when the Father sent his Son, Jesus, to save us. Our faith in Jesus leads us to a new way of looking at the world. We can see what God is doing as well as remembering what God has done.

Like the gatekeepers in Jesus' Gospel parable, we need to keep our eyes open for him. When we only look out for ourselves, we may miss the signs of God's presence around us. Instead of looking at the difficulties of life as obstacles, we can watch for them as opportunities to stretch our faith, to rely on God, or to show God's love to a friend. The recent

re-translation of the prayers of the Mass can be an opportunity to stretch our faith and our understanding of the Eucharist.

The Corinthians were also watching for the Lord to come. They were thinking of Jesus as coming in glory. Though we don't see the full glory of the Lord, part of that glory is his presence in the sacraments. In them we celebrate not just the coming of the Lord, but his working in the world. He shares his life with us in Baptism, gives us his Spirit in Confirmation and himself in the Eucharist, heals us in Reconciliation and the Anointing of the Sick, and calls us to make him present to others in Holy Orders and Matrimony. You could almost say his second coming is taking place now. Watch for it.

Commemoration of Immaculate Conception Church (decommissioned)

Friday, December 8, 2017 — 5:00 pm

Immaculate Conception Church, a mission of St. Francis Xavier Church in Baton Rouge through the collaboration of Rev. Leonard Robin and the Josephites (Society of St. Joseph of the Sacred Heart), opened its doors in the 1930's at its location on Main Street in Plaquemine to serve the community primarily attending the school which was also located there. The pastors that served the community of faith that gathered there each week were Jesuit priests assigned part time to Immaculate Conception. It also served the needs of the parishioners, families and friends. Many Catholic residents in the Plaquemine area also attended, supported and cherished the closeness to God that they experienced at Immaculate Conception.

The last baptism was celebrated on February 12, 1984 before the doors of Immaculate Conception were officially closed in 1987. Through those 50 years, the pastors that served Immaculate Conception brought peace, comfort, a deep sense of family and faith sharing to its parishioners, families, friends and the surrounding community.

In recognition of the Immaculate Conception Church, there will be a commemoration service for the faithful of Immaculate Conception Church on Friday, December 8, 2017, before the 6:00 pm Mass on the feast day of Immaculate Conception. The service will be held on the lawn near St. John the Evangelist Church statue of Mary at 5:00 pm where the bell that rang at that church has been relocated. A reception after the 6:00 pm Mass will be held in the church parish hall hosted by the Altar Society. St. John the Evangelist Church parishioners welcome and continue to open their hearts to the Immaculate Conception Church parishioners.

All Immaculate Conception parishioners are gratefully invited to attend the commemoration service, Mass and reception.
