The Way to the Kingdom

The disciples were trying to be helpful. They knew that children never approached the Rabbis. To show their respect for Jesus, they tried to turn the children away. But Jesus saw this as a chance to teach the disciples about the kingdom.

As they tried to send the children back to their parents, Jesus changes the rules. He invites the kids to come to him and even makes an example of them: "accept the kingdom of God like children" or you won't get in at all. So what do we learn from this?

Children don't make themselves look important. They haven't learned to brag about their accomplishments, or how to offer a bribe to get what they want. They simply accept what is given to them. In a culture where we are expected to make a good impression, where we compete to get scholarships and jobs, we may be more like the

disciples than we think. We cannot make ourselves look important to God; we can't bribe Him with good works or change His mind with promises to avoid sin. We can be sorry for our sins, and tell Him we love Him, and ask for help with our weaknesses.

Children also have great faith. If we can keep that faith in God's goodness, while developing a deeper faith that is not discouraged by sin and evil, we are on the way to the Kingdom.

The 165th Anniversary Mass was such a beautiful service in the packed church with the students greeting parishioners at the church doors. The Knights of Columbus were in their regalia for the procession with the twelve Marianites, three priests, one deacon and many current and former teachers at St. John School. Students were also altar servers and pole bearers while teachers served as Lectors and Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist. The high school theatre group as well as the children's choir sang after Communion, both led by David Aguillard, music director at St. John School. Following the Mass, the parish hall was filled to capacity for the reception provided by the St. John School Student Council and the St. John Church Altar Society.

The Marianites of the Holy Cross came to Plaquemine at the request of Fr. Charles Chambost, then pastor at St. John the Evangelist Church, to start the first girls' school in 1857. A boys' school and college had already started in 1853. It was the Marianites' first mission in a rural area. They had to leave during the Civil War but returned in 1865 to push forward their work of Catholic education, aptly called their "nursery of faith and the garden for the fruits of faith in later years." St. John School merged the boys' and girls' schools in later years and continues to stand, as a Catholic school always does, as a powerful auxiliary and core asset of its community and beyond wherever its graduates may go. 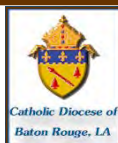




You are invited to participate in Baton Rouge's seventh **40 Days for Life** campaign this fall from September 26 through November 4, 2018.
