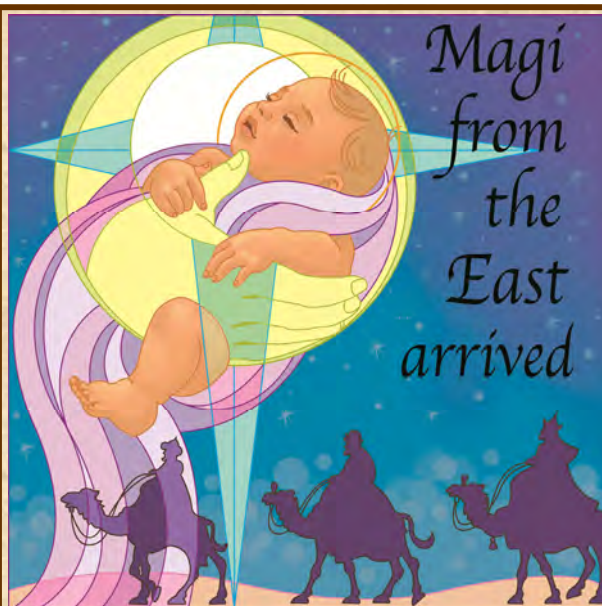

## The Epiphany of the Lord

January 6, 2019

### A Gift for the Wise Men

A rather liberal priest was teasing one of the women of the parish, asking, "How do we know the Wise Men weren't Wise Women?" She answered, "If they were, they'd have brought bottles, diapers, and a bassinet, instead of gold, frankincense, and myrrh."

The gifts, of course, are symbols of who Jesus is: a king who is both God and human. And I wonder what our gifts to the Lord say about our faith in him. Remember the song about the little drummer boy, who had no gift to bring but his ability to play the drum? It can remind us that a person who gives all they have, no matter how little it seems, is the most generous.

So what do we bring to the newborn King? I can give my time by coming to church for the feast of Epiphany and actually paying attention. Just making the effort to listen to the words of scripture, to hear what God may be trying to tell me, could be a great gift. Or I could bring someone in our family, or a friend, who doesn't go to church very much.

Now let's not forget the meaning of "epiphany." In ancient times it meant the appearance or manifestation of a divine being. Maybe a way to celebrate the Epiphany is to reflect on how God has been made known to me. Simple things, like a hug from a friend or an answered prayer, or major events like a wedding, the birth of a child, or a funeral, can all be ways to experience the Lord. The Wise Men received the gift of an epiphany by following a star. May the light of Christ lead you to him also.

**Dear Family,**

**Epiphany is one of the oldest feasts of the Christian calendar, and, as its name suggests, it is a celebration of the manifestation of Christ to the world. The Greek word *ephphaneia* means "manifestation," especially as it relates to the manifestation of a deity.**

**Our First Reading is about the reestablishment of Jerusalem after the Babylonian exile. The prophet tells the people to arise and then to allow their light to shine, because God's glory has dawned on them and radiates forth in the city to such an extent that they become the light to the nations. The Hebrew word *kabowd*, translated here as "glory," is also used to describe God's presence in the Holy of Holies. During the exile, God's glory left the Temple, but now it will return in full radiance!**

**Compare this to the Gospel that tells the story of the Magi who come from the East, perhaps Persia or Arabia, to seek out the newborn King of the Jews. Scholars of things such as dream interpretation and astrology, these men also represent the Gentile nations who come to see this great king. However, this manifestation also comes with some danger as we see in Herod's treacherous activity. The Magi's gifts of gold and frankincense are also mentioned in today's First Reading, but myrrh is a strange gift to give a mother and baby, since it was used as a painkiller and for burial. Is it possibly an omen of the future?**

**In the Second Reading, we are told that God planned from the beginning that the nations would be coheirs of the one body in Christ. Thus, we celebrate the manifestation of Christ to the world.**

**Some thoughts for reflection:**

- Reread the First Reading and create a picture in images or words of how this vision of the new Jerusalem might manifest itself. What new insights did you glean about the significance of this text?**
- When and how have you experienced God's glory in your life?**
- Prayerfully reflect on the Gospel, and converse with Mary about "all these things in her heart." What did you discover in prayer?**

**I look forward to Sunday's Concert and for crowning the Season of Christmas with beautiful music. Please keep me in your prayers as I will be taking vacation starting Monday, January 7th and will return to the office on Wednesday, January 23rd.**

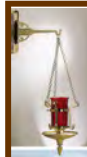

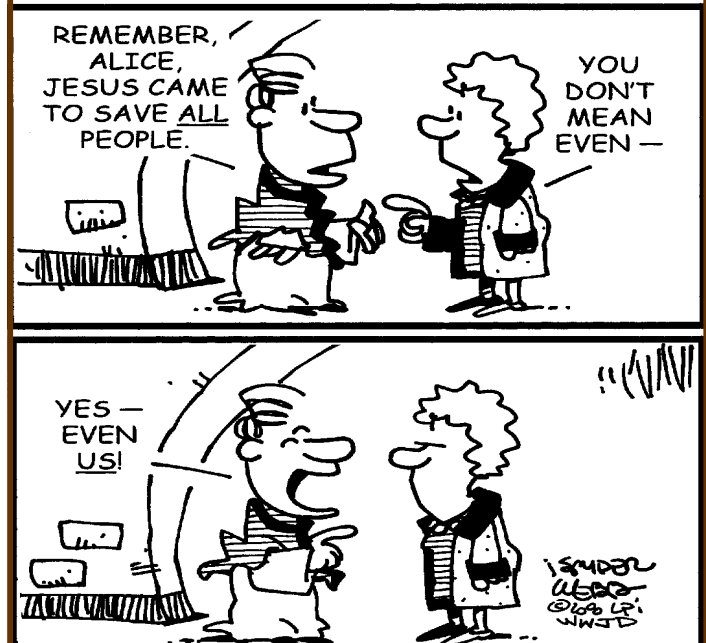
