**Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time** August 21, 2022 **Looking Good** 

Don't you love it when the underdog wins? When the Cardinals beat the Yankees for the championship or the Blues beat the Redwings, or the Rams beat anyone? Even when I watch a game with no St. Louis teams playing, I still like to root for the underdog. That is what I like about today's Gospel: the last will be first and the first will be last.

Some say that Jesus was talking about the leaders of the Jews, the scribes and Pharisees. These refused to follow Jesus, while ordinary Jews who did not feel threatened by Jesus' teaching became disciples.

In a way, you can understand why the leaders rejected Jesus. They made a nice living out of the offerings made by ordinary Jews. And who could argue with them? They worked for God. How dare Jesus say that they would be cast

out, while people from the rest of the world would enter the Kingdom of God!

And how about us? Remember that the Gospel was not written for non-believers. Are we threatened by Jesus' message? Just as the scribes and Pharisees considered themselves important in God's eyes because of their office, do we consider ourselves "saved" because we call ourselves Christians? Are we generous to the poor, or just to our friends? Do we follow our consciences or do we follow the crowd?

Entry into the Kingdom of God is not a fashion statement. We don't get there by looking good. We are invited by Jesus to be last on earth so we can be first in the Kingdom.

#### **Dear Family:**

Our readings from Isaiah and Luke focus on the theme of salvation. Is God's saving love offered to only a few? To only the Jews? To a select community? To everyone? According to the closing chapter in the Book of Isaiah, the Lord announces: "I know their works and their thoughts, and I come to gather nations of every language; they shall come and see my glory" (66:18). The text proceeds to make clear that many foreigners will be welcomed on God's holy mountain. This theme of a universal invitation from our saving God is not unusual in this prophetic book.

"Go out to all the world and tell the Good News," from the closing verses of the Gospel of Mark, is the refrain for the responsorial psalm from Psalm 117, is itself universal in nature, inviting all nations and all peoples to offer praise to God.

The Gospel passage from Luke invites us to reflect more closely on the message of Jesus as he makes his way to Jerusalem. In a manner not uncommon in Luke, a question is raised. Whose question is this? Is it really from an unknown individual or do many wonder, "Lord, will only a few people be saved"? Who will be saved? How will that be determined? Jesus does not give a clear response to the question.

#### Some questions for reflection:

- How does the invitation to all to dwell in the kingdom of God reflect God's love? How does that correspond to your love and compassion for people unlike yourself?
- Consider learning more about another religious denomination. How do the practices of the tradition resonate with practices of the Catholic faith? How do they differ?
- If Jesus were to have answered the question in the Gospel directly, how do you imagine he would have responded? Spend some time reflecting on your answer to this question.

You may have noticed that our Maintenance Building behind the Church is nearly completed. We have also received updated news from the pew manufacturer that we might have our pews for St. Clement Chapel by the end of October. This is good news since we were originally told late January of 2023 was the anticipated date of delivery. As I wrote to you earlier in this process, we are preparing to request a loan from the diocese for the completion of these two projects. If there are parishioners out there or friends of the parish and/or school who have extra funds and want to help us with these expenses, please pray and respond to our needs if possible. As always, we are grateful for all your support in prayer and treasure.


RCIA—Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults is a faith journey open to all unbaptized or baptized adults who wish to explore the possibility of becoming Catholic.
