## Second Sunday of Easter

April 27, 2025

### Believe It or Not

In today's Gospel we hear Jesus say three times, "Peace be with you." This was a common greeting, but the disciples were hiding in fear so they needed reassurance. Jesus gives them that reassurance in three ways: his resurrection, forgiveness of sins, and a blessing for future disciples.

The disciples had seen Jesus crucified and were afraid any of his followers would be treated the same way. So when Jesus appeared to them, he showed them his wounds and let them touch him. He wanted to show them that he was not a ghost; he had risen from death and death has no more power over him.

They can now take courage because they will share in the

Resurrection themselves. Breathing on them, he bestows the Holy Spirit, source of our courage.

That leads to the second reassurance, forgiveness of sins. Jesus died to take away our sins; now he shares that with his disciples. Anyone troubled by guilt can be forgiven. The disciples themselves probably felt that need, since they had deserted Jesus and one even denied knowing him. He now sends his apostles with the mission to free others from sin. We too can forgive others (and ourselves) knowing that God has forgiven them and us.

Finally, the story of Thomas and his doubts about Jesus' resurrection gives us some hope. Jesus blesses those who "have not seen and have believed" (John 20:29). We usually think the apostles were "more" blessed for having seen and heard Jesus. But Jesus reverses that expectation; we are blessed, even two thousand years after the Resurrection.

## Pastor's Letter

April 27, 2025

Dear Family:

Our Patron, John the Evangelist, wrote for disciples who did not have firsthand knowledge of Jesus. Over time, those with first hand memories of Jesus died and were succeeded in the faith by people too young to remember Jesus. But these latter disciples believed with at least as much fervor as earlier generations. In his resurrection accounts, John helped his community understand this phenomenon by showing the power of faith.

Some early disciples had visual evidence of the risen Christ. For example, in this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus appears to his disciples on Easter night and demonstrates his triumph over death by showing his wounded hands and side and passing the Spirit to them through his living breath. His demonstration is so convincing that it converts their fear to joy.

This Sunday's second reading contains a different type of visual proof, a spiritual vision of the risen Jesus. The vision includes symbolic imagery that emphasizes that the exalted Christ is truly present. He speaks with a voice like a trumpet; he is surrounded with gold lampstands reminiscent of the furnishing of the Jerusalem temple; he wears white and gold garments, like descriptions of the divine in Israelite tradition. These phenomena convince John that although this is a mystic vision, he is somehow beholding the risen Christ.

Many disciples did not have visual evidence of Christ, however. As the generations passed, other evidence became important. The first reading speaks of the many who came to believe that Jesus was Lord simply because of the merciful deeds done in his name. The story of Thomas in this Sunday's Gospel reading probably speaks to the experience of even more individuals. They believed entirely through faith in the Gospel. They may have been in danger of becoming second-class disciples who never knew the "real" Jesus, but John secures them a place as blessed individuals who could come to the truth by faith alone.

Some questions for reflection:

How has the risen Christ revealed his presence to you?

How can your mercy help another believe?

How can you share the Good News with someone who needs it?

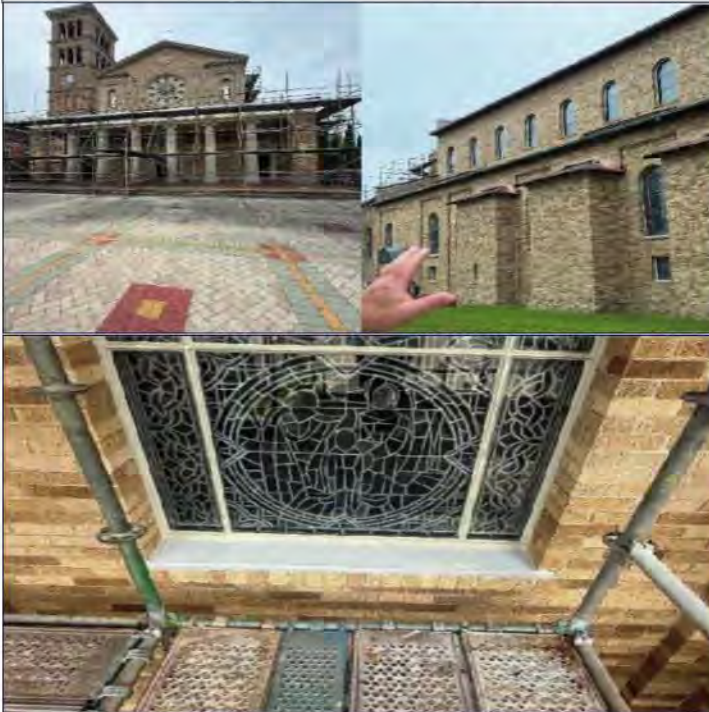

#### OBSERVATIONS:

1. Site:
  - a. Pressure washing is completed.
  - b. The Upper windows on the East side are sealed and caulked.
  - c. The Contractor is beginning to seal the window sills. The light gray color shown in the picture is only the primer. The finish coat will be darker, with more brown.
  - d. The Contractor is coordinating with the church regarding funerals and other activities. There were many funerals.
  - e. The upper roof tile work is 90% complete. The replacement beams and decking should arrive next week. Once these are installed, the upper roof work will be completed.
2. Materials:
  - a. All copper materials have been fabricated and stored in Cribbs's Warehouse. Cribbs sent pictures of the materials.
3. Outstanding RFI
  - a. Change Order No. 1 for replacing termite eaten beams and painting the existing windows has been approved. The materials are on order.
4. Outstanding RFC
  - a. None
5. Gutters for the round roof at the rear are being fabricated.
6. The Contractor will move the large man lift to the side of the church for Easter services.
7. The upper east & west side roof tile is all laid except for the area above the damaged beams. The gutter is installed.
8. The re-caulking of the high windows is complete. The contractor is now working on the lower arched head windows.
